### NOTES

- Academic Writing (AW) and Math (MA) must be attempted by 30 and completed by 60 credits.
- A grade of “D-“ or higher is required for all General Education and General Elective courses.
- Grades of “C-“ or higher are required in all *Major Requirements*.
- Students are expected to complete HLTH420 and HLTH490 in the same semester.
- All course work must be completed **prior** to beginning the Community Health Internship (HLTH491).
- A single or double major requires a minimum of 120 credits and a double degree requires a minimum of 150 credits.
