HLSA Student Travel Awards

The Department of Health Services Administration provides up to \$500 per trip to support students presenting at professional conferences. Awards are limited to 1 per student per year.

Funding decisions are based on the quality of work being presented and the likelihood that the conference will enhance the student's professional development. Preference is given to students who have not previously presented at a conference. Awards will not be granted to travel to the Population Association of America because the Maryland Population Research Center provides generous travel awards specifically to that conference. In the event that the MPRC grants are not available, talk with your advisor about funding for PAA.

Allowable Expenses

The award can be used to cover any University allowable conference related travel expense including registration, air fare, lodging, meals, ground transportation, and poster printing.

Eligibility

- Enrolled as a degree seeking student in an HLSA graduate program at the time of travel
- Have been accepted to present at a conference
- Apply for the UMD Graduate School Goldhaber Travel Grant if you are eligible.¹

Submission Deadline

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis. Please submit as soon as you are accepted to the conference to allow for sufficient review time.

Application Instructions

Complete application packets should be emailed to Michel Boudreaux (<u>mhb@umd.edu</u>). Your application package must include:

- Completed application form (see attached)
- Copy of conference abstract
- Copy of conference acceptance
- Completed Goldharber application form. Do NOT submit to Goldbarber until AFTER you have been awarded an HPM travel grant.

¹ Note that PhD students are eligible for 2 awards (one before and one after candidacy).
